AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioners Poonam Rani and Neeraj have filed present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and other family members of petitioner No.1 as they are in live-in relationship.

2. In compliance to previous order dated 31.05.2024, learned counsel representing State has filed status report, which is taken on record. Mr. Vikas Bishnoi, Advocate appeared on behalf of respondents No.4 to 7 and filed his vakalatnama, which is taken on record.

3. Respondents No.4 to 7 are present in the Court in person and all of them in one voice stated that they have no objection to the live-in relationship of petitioners and they have no intention to interfere in their life. Both petitioners are also present in the Court along with their counsel.

They have stated that they have no threat perception and they are living

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happily. They will perform marriage once petitioner No.2 attains age of 21 years.

4. Since, there is no threat perception, learned counsel for petitioners stated that he does not want to pursue present protection petition and withdraws the same.

5. In view of the statement, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
