HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner has rendered service from the year 1974 till 23.05.1990, which is more than 10 years of service hence, the petitioner is entitled for the grant of pension.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the present petition was filed but as per his instructions, the petitioner intends to approach the respondents-State by filing appropriate representation so as to consider his claim in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the petitioner files any representation raising any grievance, the same will be



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decided in accordance with law and appropriate order on the said representation will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to him otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
