1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 19.04.2024 passed in CRM-M-7931-2024.
2. Keeping in view the order dated 19.04.2024 qua which the contempt is asserted, this Court finds that there is no executable direction contained therein. Hence, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
3. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
