1. Reply dated 4.9.2024 by way of an affidavit of Pardeep Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Phul, District Bathinda has been filed by the learned State counsel today in the Court, the same is taken on record.

2. As per the office report, respondents No.3 to 8 have been duly served, however, none has appeared on their behalf. Further, respondent No.9 is stated to have been died, respondent No.10 is stated to be residing out of country and respondent No.11 could not be served for want of correct address.

3. Mr. N.S.Sidhu, Advocate has filed his duly executed *Vakalatnama* on behalf of respondent No.2 and submits that respondent No.2 is not accepting the compromise.



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4. In view of the above, the prayer, which is made for quashing of FIR No.124 dated 14.8.2016, under Sections 420, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dialpura, District Bathinda and all subsequent proceedings enumerating therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 17.8.2016 (Annexure P-2) cannot be granted and, therefore, the instant petition is **dismissed** at this stage, however, liberty is granted to the petitioners to re-access this Court in case full and final compromise is effected between the parties.
