CM-18253-CWP-2024

The instant application has been filed for seeking pre-ponement of the main case for the purpose of withdrawal of the same which is otherwise fixed for 04.03.2025.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the application is allowed and main case is ordered to be taken up on the Board today itself.



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CM-18254-CWP-2024

The instant application has been filed for seeking withdrawal of the main case.

For the reasons mentioned in the applications, the present application is allowed.

CM-17498-CWP-2024

The present application has been filed for impleading applicants as party respondents No.6 and 7 (both plaintiffs in Civil Suit No. 19444 of 2023 appended as Annexure P-4 in the writ petition).

Since the main writ petition has been disposed as withdrawn by the applicant-petitioner, no further action is required to be taken in the present application.

Hence, the present application is dismissed at this stage with liberty to the applicant-petitioner to pursue his alternative remedies in accordance with law.

CWP-14269-2024

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant-petitioner contends that the matter is already pending before the Civil Court and he seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition so as to take his alternative remedies before the Civil Court. He further request that the Civil Court may be directed to take an expeditious decision on the



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pending applications that have been preferred by the respondent-Bank.

The petitioner has separately moved CM-18254-CWP-2024 for seeking withdrawal of the writ petition which is duly supported by way of an affidavit of the petitioner-Harkiran Singh Sodhi son of Ravinder Singh Sodhi, resident of House No. 42-A, Gate No.3, Near New Krishna Mandir, Model Town Extn. Ludhiana.

The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to the applicant-petitioner to pursue his case before the Civil Court.

The Civil Court is also directed to take an expeditious decision on the pending application (Annexure A-1) filed before this Court and pending before the Civil Court whereby a clarification has been sought by the Bank in relation to pending FDRs.

Let a decision be taken upon expeditiously and preferably within a period of two months from the date next fixed before the trial Court after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn.
