By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the
petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under: -

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance
to the orders dated 31.05.2024 and 17.07.2024, the petitioners have joined
the investigation.

3. During the course of hearing on 31.05.2024, following order
had been passed: -



“ 2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR nor any specific attribution is there but a false case has been planted on them on the alleged disclosure statement made by the co-accused, namely Dheeraj and Gurdutt Singh. He contends that the petitioners are not having any criminal antecedents nor there is any recovery of narcotics. He contends that entire case has been hatched against the petitioners on mere presumptions just to harass them.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and prays for time to file the status report/reply in the matter.

5. Adjourned to 17.07.2024.

6. Needful be done well before the date fixed with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

7. In the meanwhile, the petitioners are hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of their arrest, they are ordered to be released on interim bail on their furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. They shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

8. Investigating Officer (concerned) to remain present in Court on the next date of hearing along with relevant records.”

4. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jitender informs the Court that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioners had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 31.05.2024 and 17.07.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide orders dated 31.05.2024 and 17.07.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioners are directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioners; they will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

6. The petition stands allowed.

7. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
