MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.65 dated 26.04.2024 under Sections 420/465/467/468/471 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

2. On 03.07.2024, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had issued notice of motion:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset submits that though a false case has been planted upon the petitioner by twisting the facts, yet the petitioner is willing to deposit Rs.1,15,000/-, the amount allegedly transferred into his bank account by the complainant, on an assurance given for getting him a Government job. Learned counsel submits that within the next two weeks, the petitioner would pay back the said amount.”

3. Thereafter, vide order dated 14.08.2024, the petitioner had been granted interim bail and asked to join investigation.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 14.08.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Karamjeet Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

6. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 14.08.2024, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS/438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
