1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the judgment and decree dated 27.01.1998 passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Gurgaon.
2. Perusal of the case file shows that the judgment and decree qua which the contempt is alleged, have been passed by the Civil Court. The said Court is having sufficient power and wide competence to get its own order/decreed executed. The petitioner can get the aforesaid judgment/decreed executed or get his grievance remedied by availing an appropriate modality before the Court below.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise his grievance before the Court below, but in accordance with law.
