1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for quashing the impugned order dated 22.05.2024 passed by Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Jalandhar in Execution No. EXE 439 of 2024.

It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the decree holder/petitioner Gurdial Singh had made a statement before the Executing Court that he had received the possession of the premises in question on 07.09.2024 and thus, he did not wish to proceed with the execution and the same was dismissed as withdrawn and accordingly, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
