Present civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 28.05.2019 (P-2) passed by learned Additional Deputy Commissioner-cum-Appellate Tribunal, Rupnagar, whereby petitioners were ordered to be evicted from the house in question.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.2, on instructions, submits that as on today, respondent No. 2 is having no grievance against the petitioners; rather they are taking care of him.

3. Since no one is appearing on behalf of the petitioners; therefore, in view of the above position, it seems that petitioners are not interested in pursuing the matter.
