1. Vide this application, the applicant-petitioner is seeking permission to place on record order dated 02.02.2024 passed by respondent No.3 vide which the representation dated 24.05.2022 annexed with the petition (Annexure P-9) has been rejected.

2. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and order dated 02.02.2024 is taken on record as Annexure P-11 subject to all just exceptions.

Main case

1. Learned counsel for the respondents have informed this Court that the representation dated 24.05.2022 made by the petitioner stands decided and rejected by the respondents vide order dated 02.02.2024 and against the order passed on 02.02.2024 legal remedy are available.
2. Keeping in view that legal remedy of appeal is available, the present petition is dismissed, granting liberty to the petitioner to take up the legal remedy for challenging the order dated 02.02.2024.
3. It is made clear that all the grounds taken in the writ petition are left open for the petitioner to raise in his appeal.
