1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 26.04.2018 passed in CWP-24467-2017.
2. Keeping in view the fact that vide order dated 26.04.2018 passed in CWP-24467-2017, liberty was granted to the petitioner to approach the office of the respondents in case any grievance survives, this Court does not find any ground to interfere by way of the present petition.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
4. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy in terms of the order dated 26.04.2018 passed in CWP-24467-2017.
5. Pending application, if any, shall stand disposed of.
