Prayer in this writ petition filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for setting-aside the office order No.186 dated 10.08.2021 (Annexure P-7) and impugned office order No.187 dated 10.08.2021 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.5 whereby the previous office order No.419 dated 29.12.2020 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.5, being the competent appointing and punishing authority under the Rules, has been withdrawn and further for setting-aside the impugned charge-sheet No.2 dated 28.01.2021 issued by respondent No.5. Further a writ of mandamus has been sought for directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to join his duty since 30.04.2018 in the office of respondent No.5 and pay him the salaries from the date when he filed his arrival report on 30.04.2018 along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of its accrual along with other consequential monitory benefits till its actual payment.



Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits that the impugned office order No.186 dated 10.08.2021 (Annexure P-7) and impugned office order No.187 dated 10.08.2021 (Annexure P-8) whereby fresh enquiry was ordered against the petitioner shall be withdrawn and therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as having become infructuous.
