KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. After arguing for some time, when finding that all the issues as raised through the instant petition, are purely disputed question of facts, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the instant petition, at this stage, and seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the same, with liberty to raise all such pleas, as raised through the instant petition, before the learned trial Court concerned, at an appropriate stage.
2. **Dismissed as withdraw** with the aforesaid liberty.
3. At this stage, he submits that the petitioner being a lady of 59 years of age, her personal appearance before the learned trial court concerned, may be exempted.
4. The petitioner is at liberty to file an application for seeking exemption before the learned trial court concerned.
5. In case such application is filed, the learned trial court concerned, shall pass an appropriate order in accordance with law.
