In the present petition, the grievance raised by the petitioners is that the petitioners have discharged the duties with the respondents but they have not been paid their salary starting from 30.09.2021 to 30.03.2022, which act on the part of the respondents is arbitrary and illegal and the respondents are liable to be directed to release the salary to the petitioners forthwith.

From the pleadings it transpires that the grievance which has been raised by the petitioners in the present petition has already been raised in the legal notice dated 12.07.2023 and thereafter in the representation dated 03.05.2024, copies of which have been appended as Annexure P-3 and P-4 respectively.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 12.07.2023 and thereafter in the representation dated 03.05.2024, copies of which have been appended as Annexure P-3 and P-4 respectively have been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners.

Keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the statement of the learned State counsel.
