Present civil writ petition has been filed for restraining respondent No.4 from creating third party rights by way of lease/rent/transfer/sale etc. over the land under cultivating possession of the petitioner as gair marusi, measuring 150 bigha and 2 biswas, khatouni number 1644, situated in village and tehsil Banur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali as per Jamabandi for the year 2021-2022 (Annexure P-1). Further prayer has been made that dispossession of the petitioner be stayed and to direct the respondents-authorities to take action on the application dated 15.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed representation dated 25.04.2024 (Annexure P-3) before the respondent No.2 but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if his representation dated 25.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) is decided in a time bound manner.



Notice of motion to the official respondents.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajeev Takkar, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. A copy of the paperbook has been handed over to him.

Heard.

After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.2 i.e. Deputy Commissioner, District SAS Nagar, Mohali is directed to look into the representation dated 25.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner and decide the same expeditiously preferably within four weeks from today, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
