Present civil writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents-authorities to take appropriate action as per law including action under the Punjab Municipal Act, 1911 to prevent/prohibit the respondents No.7, 8 and 9 from encroaching upon the property of the Municipal Council Rahon, situated on Machiwara Road, on the turn towards the way of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar Nagar as depicted in the Site Plan annexed with Report of the Patwari, Rahon dated 16.03.2023 (Annexure P-1). Further prayer has been made to direct the Respondent-Authorities to act upon and favourably decide the representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) duly submitted before the respondent-authorities after affording an opportunity of being heard to the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) before the respondents but the same has not been taken into consideration till date. He has further submitted that the



petitioner would be satisfied if his representation dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 6.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajeev Takkar, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At this stage, Mr. Manbir Singh Batth, Advocate has put in appearance and filed memorandum of appearance on behalf of respondent No.5 in the Court today and same is taken on record.

Heard.

After hearing counsel for the parties, respondent No.5 i.e. The Executive Officer, Municipal Council, Rahon, SBS Nagar is directed to look into the representation filed by the petitioner dated 08.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) and decide the same expeditiously preferably within four weeks from today, in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
