Short reply by way of an affidavit of Shri Surinder Singh, PPS,
Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central Amritsar has been filed on behalf
of respondent- State in CRM-M-30438-2023 titled as “Davinder Singh v.
State of Punjab”. Learned State counsel has made a statement that said reply
may also be considered for CRM-M-29973-2023 titled as “Nishan Singh v.
State of Punjab”.

Both the petitioners were allowed interim anticipatory bail. Petitioner Nishan Singh was allowed interim anticipatory vide order dated 07.06.2023 whereas petitioner Davinder Singh was allowed interim anticipatory bail vide order dated 14.06.2023.

As per the statement made by learned State counsel, both the petitioners have since joined the investigation but not co-operating in the same. Learned State counsel is unable to convince this Court as to in what manner the petitioners are not co-operating.

Since petitioners have joined the investigation, as such, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, order dated 07.06.2023 in CRM-M-29973-2023 & order dated 14.06.2023 in CRM-M-30438-2023 are hereby made absolute, whereby petitioners were granted interim anticipatory bail.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
