In the present petition, grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner is working as a part-time sweeper with the respondents since 01.04.1997 and under the policy dated 29.07.2011 (Annexure P/2) the petitioner is claiming benefit of regularization of his service as the petitioner is utterly eligible for the said benefit but no action has been taken by the respondents especially, when the petitioner has been working for more than 27 years with the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance by way of serving a legal notice dated 08.03.2023 (Annexure P/5), which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction be



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issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 08.03.2023 (Annexure P/5) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
