1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 02.05.2024 passed in LPA-905-2024.

3. Mr. Pawan Kumar Longia, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
4. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 02.05.2024 passed in LPA-905-2024 has since been complied with and the petitioner has been offered appointment to the post of TGT (Social Studies) and she has joined, as such.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
