The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to issue the Registration Certificate against the applications for registration of two Societies applied by the petitioner i.e. International Bar Guild or IBG and Society of Indian Lawyers or SIL without any further delay.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as regards to his grievances mentioned in the petition, the petitioner has already sent a representation dated 30.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) to the respondents and he would be satisfied in case respondent No.4 is directed to consider and decide the said representation by passing a well reasoned and speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.3 and 4 only at this stage.



Mr. Abhinav Sood, Advocate and Ms. Achintaya Soni, Advocate, enter appearance on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4. They submit that they have no objection to the aforesaid prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

With the consent of the parties, the present petition is accordingly **disposed of** without commenting on the merits of the present case and with a direction to respondent No.4—Registrar of Firms and Societies, UT Chandigarh, to take note of the representation dated 30.05.2024 (Annexure P-4) sent by the petitioner and to pass a well reasoned and speaking order thereupon after granting an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties in accordance with law and preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
