The petitioner has filed the present petition for issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 and 3, to decide the representation dated 04.03.2024 (Annexure P-1), within the stipulated timeframe.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was having House No.63, Street No.1, Hargobind Nagar, Ludhiana. While the petitioner was away to Delhi, where he was doing job, on 02.03.2024, respondents No.4 to 7 had come to the house of the petitioner with two tempos and they have broken the locks of the house of the petitioner and had taken away all the valuable and movable items from the house. Relating to the same, the petitioner had filed a complaint at the official portal on 03.03.2024, vide UID No.312587, which was marked to ASI Sukhjinder Singh. Copy of the said



complaint has been supplied by learned counsel for the petitioner today in the Court, which is taken on record.

Further, it is submitted that it is the grievance of the petitioner that no action is being taken on the aforesaid complaint. Furthermore, on 04.03.2024, a representation was made before Commissioner of Police and SHO, P.S. Shimlapuri, Ludhiana, copy whereof is Annexure P-1, but however, no action has been initiated upon the same and the said representation is still pending.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Solomon Partap Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No.1 to 3 and gives assurance about disposal of the representation dated 04.03.2024 (Annexure P-1), in accordance with law.

In the given circumstances, on the assurance given by learned State Counsel, it is ordered that respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, shall dispose of the representation dated 04.03.2024 (Annexure P-1), within a period of seven days from today onwards and initiate any kind of action, in accordance with law, if called for.

In view of the aforesaid terms, the instant petition is hereby disposed of.
