1. After addressing arguments for some time, when this Court was not inclined to grant the asked for relief, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the instant petition, however, he submits that since the petitioner is behind bars since 12.5.2022 and only 4 witnesses out of total 14 cited witnesses have been examined till date, therefore, he made a request that directions be passed upon the learned trial Court concerned to decide the trial expeditiously.
2. The innocuous and bonafide prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is accepted.
3. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed** as withdrawn.
4. However, the learned trial Court concerned is directed to make all efforts to conclude the trial most expeditiously. The SSP concerned shall also ensure the presence of all the prosecution witnesses as and when called upon by the learned trial Court concerned.
