[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] Prayer in the petition under Section 10/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 03.02.2020 in CWP No.12859 of 2017.

[3] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 03.02.2020 reveals that CWP No.12859 of 2017 was allowed. Operative part of the order is reproduced as under:-

*“Keeping in view above observations, writ petition is allowed and direction is being given to the respondents to regularize services of the petitioner in terms of policy dated 01.10.2003 (Annexure P-4) with all consequential benefits along with 6% interest and pass appropriate order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and this Court be informed of the order passed.”*

[4] Learned State counsel has placed on record copy of order dated 18.11.2020 in LPA No.818 of 2020 issuing notice of motion and granting interim order in the same terms as in LPA No.444 of 2020. Learned State counsel states that in LPA No.444 of 2020, operation of the judgment of the learned Single Judge was stayed vide order dated 20.07.2020.

[5] In view of the orders of Hon’ble the Division Bench as referred to above, the instant petition is disposed of at this stage as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition in case of vacation of stay or the LPA being decided in favour of the petitioner.
