The petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court, for issuance of direction to official respondents No.2 and 3, to protect their lives and liberty.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that both the petitioners are major and to so substantiate qua their age, Aadhar cards of both the petitioners have been placed on record. It is further submitted by learned counsel that both the petitioners, who are major, have solemnized marriage on 29.04.2024. Copy of the marriage certificate is Annexure P-3. However, now the private respondents did not like the said relationship and they are extending threats to the lives and liberty of the petitioners. Respondent No.4-Satpal is father of petitioner No.1-Aarzoo and respondents No.5 and 6 are the uncle of petitioner No.1 and Sapranch of the village, respectively. Also, it is submitted that representation dated 30.05.2024 has been filed before Superintendent of Police, Sira, through e-mail, copy whereof is Annexure P-4, but no action has been initiated upon the same.



Notice of motion.

Ms. Dimple Jain, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that in the present case, FIR No.88, dated 14.03.2024 under Sections 363 and 366-A IPC has been registered at Police Station, Sadar Sirsa, against petitioner No.2-Sulender Kumar, at the behest of respondent No.4, who is the father of petitioner No.1.

In any case, the representation at the behest of the petitioners is pending adjudication.

In the given circumstances, on the assurance given by learned State Counsel, it is ordered that Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, shall dispose of the representation dated 30.05.2024 (Annexure P-4), within a period of seven days from today onwards and initiate any kind of action, in accordance with law, if called for.

However, these observations are circumscribed only for the purposes of disposal of the present petition, without prejudice to the rights of the parties, to be adjudicated in any civil or criminal proceedings, qua the age of the petitioners, factum of marriage and the validity thereof.

In view of the aforesaid terms, the instant petition is hereby disposed of.
