NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners, who are working as daily-wage workers with the respondents.
2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 24.01.2024, the following order was passed :-

“Request for an adjournment has been made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4.

The present writ petition relates to the year 2012 and is being adjourned on one pretext or the other.

Although, there is no justification of adjournment, however, in the interest of justice, case is adjourned to 10.05.2024.



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It is made clear that no further adjournment shall be granted on the next date of hearing to either of the parties.”

3. Since, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners, therefore, the present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
