This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been filed for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 728 dated 21.09.2022 registered under Section 20 of The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 20(c), 27-A and 29 of the NDPS Act added and Section 20 of the NDPS Act deleted later on) registered at P.S. Hansi City, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged recovery of narcotic substance i.e. Sulfa which is allegedly recovered from the petitioner is non-commercial in nature. He further contends that the petitioner is not a habitual offender as he is not involved in any other case whatsoever.

Learned State Counsel has filed custody certificate, the same is taken on record. As per the same, the petitioner is involved in one more FIR No. 426/2022 dated 14.08.2022 registered under Sections



20C/61/85 of the NDPS Act at P.S. Narnaund, District Hisar wherein also he is stated to be not on bail.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant case at this stage.

Allowed as prayed for.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
