1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Section 151 CPC for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 18.08.2023 passed in CWP-17907-2023.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Aditya Sharda, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and files the reply by way of affidavit of the respondent. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.

4. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 18.08.2023 passed in CWP-17907-2023 has been complied with and legal notice of the petitioner has been decided by the respondent while passing the speaking order dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure R-1).

5. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
