Learned counsel for the appellants informs that appellant No.1- Harjinder Kaur has unfortunately died during the pendency of the instant appeal, therefore, the enhanced amount of compensation be disbursed to appellants No.2 and 3, who are the legal representatives of appellant No.1.

As per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.9,00,000/- (Rs.Nine Lacs Sixty Thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant(s) in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. The enhanced amount be paid to the appellants No.2 and 3.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.9,00,000/- in the name of the appellanta No.2 and 3 with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent–Insurance Company. The appellants' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
