1. Instant Writ Petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits such as gratuity and leave encashment after the retirement of the petitioner in view of the resolutions dated 28.02.2019 and 21.11.2022 (Annexures P-2 and P-4) along with interest @ 18% per annum on the delayed payment till its realization.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.5 – Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Rupnagar, to consider and decide the representation dated 18.03.2024 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner.

4. Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State.



5. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.5 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
