HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the process of refixation of pay/pensionary benefits by including the benefit of 03 ACPs along with arrears has been finalized and the amount payable to the petitioner shall be released within a period of 02 weeks from today.

2. In view of the above, no further direction is required to be issued in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as

costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation

expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

3. Rule stands discharged.
