1. This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case DDR No.41, dated 14.06.2023, under Sections 323, 324, 34 of IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, in FIR No.107, dated 09.06.2023, under Sections 323, 341, 148, 149 of IPC, Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Vide order dated 19.06.2024, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harbajan Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 19.06.2024, petitioner has joined investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order dated 19.06.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

6. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
