1. Learned counsel submits that the monthly pension that the petitioner was receiving after the demise of her husband on 26.04.2021, when he was working as a Peon, has been stopped. While on the other hand, her prayer for grant of Rs.5,00,000/- as Special Compassionate Financial Assistance on account of death of her husband due to Covid has been approved by the Director. In this regard, representation, Annexure P-7, was submitted followed by representation dated 04.05.2024, Annexure P-8. He thus, at this stage, on instructions, submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case, a direction is given to the respondents to decide her representations in a time bound manner.

2. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made

by learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. In view of the aforesaid and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the authorities to whom the representations have been addressed to decide the same within a period of three months in accordance with law.
