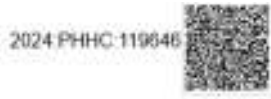

HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for setting aside the order dated 08.07.2014 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned District Revenue Officer cum Settlement Officer, Consolidation, Karnal.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners refers to para No.8 of the status report dated 23.05.2024 filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, which reads as under:

That some of the residents of village have also filed the appeals before the court of Collector, Karnal, against the orders passed by the District Revenue Officer-cum-Settlement Officer, Karnal and the court of Collector, Karnal, vide its order dated 8.5.2023 has remanded back



the cases to the court of District Revenue Officer, Karnal, with the directions to pass a speaking order after considering the instructions mentioned in the Notification 9.8.2011 issued by the Commissioner, Rohtak Division, Rohtak. The aforesaid Balvinder Singh etc. have also challenged the remand order dated 8.5.2023 by way of appeal before the court of Commissioner, Karnal and the same is pending therein.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the light of the aforesaid para he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail his other remedies in accordance with law.
4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
5. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
