1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to consider him for the rank of Inspector w.e.f. 05.12.2003.
2. The petitioner is claiming that he should be considered for the post of Inspector w.e.f. 05.12.2003. He is claiming parity with similarly situated sportspersons.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue involved in the instant petition is squarely covered by judgment dated 10.01.2024 passed by this Court in *CWP-26710-2019*.
4. Learned State counsel does not dispute the applicability of aforesaid judgment to the case in hand, however, submits that respondent-

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State has filed Intra-Court Appeal (*LPA No.1627 of 2024*) which is pending for consideration before a Division Bench of this Court.

5. On being asked by this Court, learned State counsel confirms that no stay has been granted by the Division Bench.

6. As there is no stay in favour of respondent-State, this Court finds its appropriate to dispose of the instant petition in terms of judgment dated 10.01.2024 passed by this Court in *CWP No.26710 of 2019*.

7. Accordingly, the present petition is hereby disposed of in terms of order passed in *CWP No.26710 of 2019*.
