DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

1. The present intra court appeal is directed against judgment dated 23.11.2023 by a learned Single Judge of this Court dismissing the appellant's writ petition filed by him for quashing of result through which no candidate, including the appellant, had been found suitable by the selection committee for appointment as an Associate Professor.

2. After hearing the learned counsel for the appellant and going through the record, which includes the impugned judgment, we find that the learned Single Judge has dismissed the appellant's writ petition on the ground that merely because the appellant had possessed the prescribed qualification and had experience of teaching Law for over a decade, he had no vested right to be appointed to the post in question. He only had the right of consideration of his candidature as per the applicable procedure. The learned Single Judge further rejected the appellant's claim on the ground that the appellant had not disputed that his candidature had been considered by the duly formed selection committee which had not found any candidate suitable for appointment to the post in question and that once academic experts had arrived at the afore conclusion, no exception to the same could be made especially when the



appellant has neither pointed out any irregularity in the selection process nor alleged any *mala fides*.

- 3. In the facts of the present case, the afore findings returned by the learned Single Judge do not warrant any interference.
- 4. Dismissed.
- 5. All pending miscellaneous applications also stand disposed of.
