1. The present writ petition has been filed alleging that despite an interim order passed by this Court in CWP-19248-2018, the respondents have changed the location of the Transformer.

2. Ms. Avin Kaur Sandhu, Advocate, who on an advance notice enters appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 and has informed that the said factual assertion is incorrect, as there is no change in location of the Transformer and that only the capacity of the Transformer already existing has been augmented in order to cater to the enhanced load. She further contends that in the event the petitioner has any grievance as to whether any application for enhancement of the load was entertained or not and as to whether any such application would be in conflict with an interim order passed in CWP-19248-2018, such a grievance cannot be espoused by means of a independent petition, and the petitioner would be required to move an



appropriate application, if so advised, in CWP-19248-2018 itself.

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage, so as to take recourse to an appropriate remedy and/or to move an appropriate application in CWP-19248-2018, as advised.

4. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 has no objection to the same.

5. Disposed of as not pressed with the liberty as aforesaid.
