Learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Gaurav from Police Station Sohna, District Gurugram, apprises the Court that out of total 14 witnesses cited by the prosecution in the Final Police Report under Section 173 Cr.P.C (Challan), 13 witnesses have already been examined and now, the case is scheduled to be listed before the trial Court on 19.10.2024.

2. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the trial proceedings are nearing conclusion, therefore, he does not want to press for the adjudication of the present petition but he prays that the trial Court be directed to decide the case at the earliest possible.

3. Learned State counsel has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Resultantly, the petition in hand is, hereby, dismissed as having not been pressed, with the direction to the concerned trial Court to conclude the trial proceedings in the criminal case under reference and to decide the same, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
