MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 407, dated 07.12.2022, under Section 346 of IPC (Section 376 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Maqboolpura, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.
2. Vide order dated 01.12.2023, passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 01.12.2023, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
