1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the orders dated 10.03.2023 (Annexure P-4) and 19.05.2023 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), SAS Nagar, Mohali and Additional District Judge, SAS Nagar, Mohali respectively vide which the application filed by the petitioner under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC for restraining the respondent No.1 has been dismissed.
