HARKESH MANUJA, J. (ORAL)

By way of present revision petition, challenge has been made to judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 12.02.2018 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, whereby the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 02.02.2016 passed by the trial Court against the revisionist-petitioner, was upheld.

[2] This Court, vide order dated 27.03.2018, passed the following order:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not pressing the petition on merits but only on the quantum of sentence, the petitioner having been sentenced to 02 years rigorous imprisonment for the commission of an offence punishable under Section 304-A IPC, in addition to paying a fine of Rs. 5,000/-, to be paid to the family members of each of the two deceased.

He would take instructions as to any compensation awarded to the legal heirs of both the deceased in any proceedings before a Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal.

Adjourned to 05.04.2018. ”

[3] Pursuant to above order dated 27.03.2018, the petitioner only pressed on the issue of quantum of sentence.

[4] Learned State Counsel submits that as per the information provided in the custody certificate, the petitioner has already completed his period of sentence and has been released thereafter on 01.10.2019, thereby rendering the present petition as infructuous.

[5] In view of the above, present petition is **disposed off** as having been rendered infructuous.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
