1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.58 dated 30.04.2024, under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of IPC Act, registered at Police Station Mullapur, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).
2. Vide order dated 10.07.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 10.07.2024, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.



6. In view of the above, interim order dated 10.07.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

7. Petition stands allowed.
