By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR (Annexure P-1) as under:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners have submitted that in compliance to the order dated 20.06.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation and as such interim bail granted to the petitioners may be confirmed.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions received from ASI Sarwan Singh has intimated that the petitioners have joined investigation



and are no more required for any custodial investigation in this case nor they are required for further investigation.

4. Heard.

5. During the course of hearing on 20.06.2024, the following order was passed:-

“ Learned State counsel prays for another adjournment to file status report/reply in the matter.

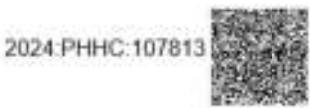
The averments made in the said order have not been disputed on behalf of the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that till the next date of hearing, the interim protection be granted to the petitioners.

Adjourned to 21.08.2024.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioners had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 20.06.2024 passed by this Court, interim bail granted vide order dated 20.06.2024 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Further the petitioners are directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioners; they will not tamper with the evidence nor will



influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.
