By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.390 dated 06.12.2022 registered under Sections 294, 307, 323, 326 and 506 IPC at Police Station Bawal, Rewari, Haryana.

2. The allegations against the petitioner is to have inflicted a knife blow in the abdomen of Mahesh. The FIR was lodged on the complaint of Lalit Devi, mother of Mahesh. It is informed today that statement of injured – Mahesh has already been recorded whereas examination-in-chief of complainant – Lalit Devi has also been recorded though her cross-examination has been deferred.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year 02 months and 22 days and that trial may take long time to conclude, so, he be allowed bail.

4. Learned State Counsel does not dispute the factual position that statement of injured – Mahesh has already been recorded. The custody certificate placed on record reveals that the petitioner is in custody for the last 01 year 02 months and 22 days. He has no other criminal case pending against him. Injured-

Mahesh has already been examined. Trial may take time to conclude. This is a single injury case. No purpose shall be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

5. In view of all the afore-said facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
