1. Petitioners Kavita and Sanju have filed present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 .
2. Learned counsel representing the State has filed status report, which is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for petitioners pointed out that petitioners are living happily and there is no threat perception since matter has been settled. Therefore, he does not want to pursue the present petition and withdraws the same.
