SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0002 dated 06.01.2022, under Section 506 IPC and Section 12 & 8 of POCSO Act, 2012, registered at Women Police Station, Faridabad, District Faridabad (Haryana).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and the complainant in collusion with the police has implicated him in the present case to grab money.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking, Mr. Aditya Pal Singla, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

5. Learned State counsel submits that challan was presented and charges were framed under Section 506 IPC and Sections 12 & 8 of POCSO Act, 2012 on 20.03.2022. He further submits that there are 12 witnesses and

the next date before the trial Court for examination of witnesses is 23.02.2024.

6. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and gone through the record, available before this Court.

7. Since the charges have been framed under Section 12 and 8 of POCSO Act and trial is going on, therefore, no ground is made out to quash the abovesaid FIR.

8. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
