The petitioners are seeking a direction from this Court to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life & liberty from the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 is of marriageable age but petitioner No.2 is yet to attain the same but as both the petitioners have decided to get married with each other as and when law permits, petitioner No.1 has started living with the family of petitioner No.2 but petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents, who are the parents/relative of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the

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petitioners have submitted a representation dated 30.05.2024 (Annexure P/3) with the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Ferozepur and prays that a direction be issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Kuljeet Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, representation dated 30.05.2024 (Annexure P/3) has been received from the petitioners, the same will be decided by the respondent No.2 by passing appropriate speaking order within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, any merit is found in the said representation, the appropriate action will be taken by respondent No.2 to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
