The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.441 dated 12.07.2023 registered under Sections 409, 420, 465, 468 and 471 read with Section 120-B IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sadar, Gurugram.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.06.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
