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DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's mother expired on 24.05.2024; her bhog ceremony is on 10.06.2024 to be held at House No.816/28, Gali No.13, Jyoti Park, Gurugram, Haryana; the petitioner seeks to attend his mother's bhog ceremony and that on an earlier occasion when the petitioner was released on interim bail he has not misused such concession.

2. Learned State counsel does not dispute the above facts.

3. After considering the fact that the petitioner's mother expired on 24.05.2024 and her bhog ceremony is to take place on 10.06.2024, it is directed that after taking adequate security measures the State shall take the petitioner in police custody on 09.06.2024 at 10 a.m. to attend the bhog ceremony of his mother and thereafter get him back to the jail where he is housed on 10.06.2024 at 5:30 pm.

4. It is clarified that expenses to be incurred by the State in taking the petitioner and bringing him back in police custody shall be borne by the petitioner.
