GURBIR SINGH, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC. for anticipatory bail in case FIR No.555 dated 04.10.2023 under Sections 420 of IPC 1860 (Sections 467/468/471/120-B of IPC were added later on) registered at Police Station Pinjore & Economic Offences Wing, Panchkula.

2. The report dated 13.08.2024 from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court has been received wherein it is stated that the parties have settled the matter by way of settlement/agreement dated 13.08.2024. The same has already been placed on record.

3. Learned counsel for the complainant affirms the factum of the compromise.

4. Since the matter has already been settled between the parties, so the present petition is allowed.

6. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be admitted to

bail on furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

7. The parties shall be bound by the terms and conditions of the agreement and they are advised to file joint petition for quashing of the FIR in question.
